WHAT TO EXPECT

- ◆ **We are asking you to wear face coverings.** *All employees, members and visitors in attendance shall wear face coverings before, during and after the service, whether indoors or outdoors. Please, continue to wear face coverings to sing – it must stay on for the duration of the service.*
- ◆ **The double doors in the lower lot will be our only access point.**
- ◆ **There will be no sharing of the peace before service or receiving line after church to maximize social distancing.**
- ◆ **Please do not attend church or other church activities if you have a respiratory illness or feel like they are coming down with one for at least 14 days after your full recovery.** Family members should not attend either.
- ◆ **If you are high risk, consider not attending service.** We will continue to stream our worship services for those who cannot attend.
- ◆ **Offering collection: We will not be passing the collection plate during the offertory.** Please either drop your offering in the collection plates by the door or give online. Alternatively, you may mail a check to the church office.
- ◆ **Communion will be coming in prepackaged hosts and cups, of both wine and grape juice. We are planning on having communion only 2 times a month (1st and 3rd Sundays.)** Pastor will consecrate the communion elements during the service and we will commune together in the service at the designated time for communion. There will be a receptacle at the door for disposing the supplies upon leaving the sanctuary.
- ◆ **There will be an elder who will be writing down those attending service.** If an outbreak occurs, this information will allow us to have a way to contact individuals that may have been exposed which may be critical to help save lives.

In The Holy Spirit

Read John 7:37-39. What is the great festival that verse 37 is referring to? Do you know what traditions were done with this festival? What is significant about Jesus crying out loudly at this time of the festival?

Who were the thirsty people, Jesus was referring to? Who are the thirsty people today? What makes us all thirst and struggle to find our refreshment in God alone?

What are the two things Jesus says will quench the thirst? How do people truly come to Jesus? Then how is it they drink in his love, grace, and joy?

How do the Scriptures cause living water to flow within our lives, like Jesus said? What can cause us to overlook and not feel the Holy Spirit flowing into our lives? How can we balance remembering both the inward movement of the Spirit in our lives with the call of the Spirit to go out to the ends of the earth?

While the Spirit had not been outpoured at this time, how do we still see the Holy Spirit at work in this section of Scripture?

Going on let's read, John 7:40-43. How did the crowd react to Jesus' words? Throughout the Gospels what were different reactions to Jesus?

What are different reactions to Jesus today? How might the Holy Spirit work in the midst of those different opinions?
